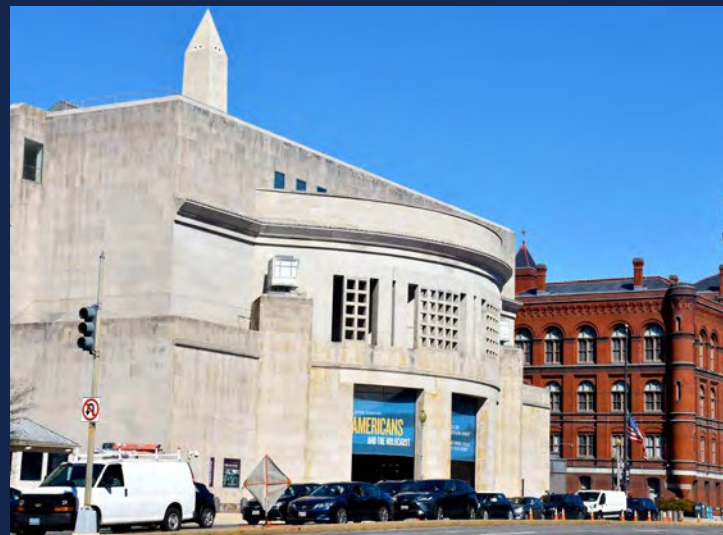

The **Two Museums Program** is aimed at inspiring college age students to unite to face the current challenges posed by antisemitism, anti-black racism, and intolerance and hatred of all kinds.

Led on the ground by Dr. David Machlis and Professor Joseph Celentano, both from Adelphi University, students interested in reaching across boundaries to build a better world for all humanity participate in guided visits to two landmark Washington DC museums – the **National Museum of African American History and Culture (NMAAHC)** and the **United States Holocaust Memorial Museum (USHMM)**.

This is a comprehensive scholarship opportunity for undergraduate interns in Washington DC. The program includes educational components delivered by renowned scholars throughout the program.

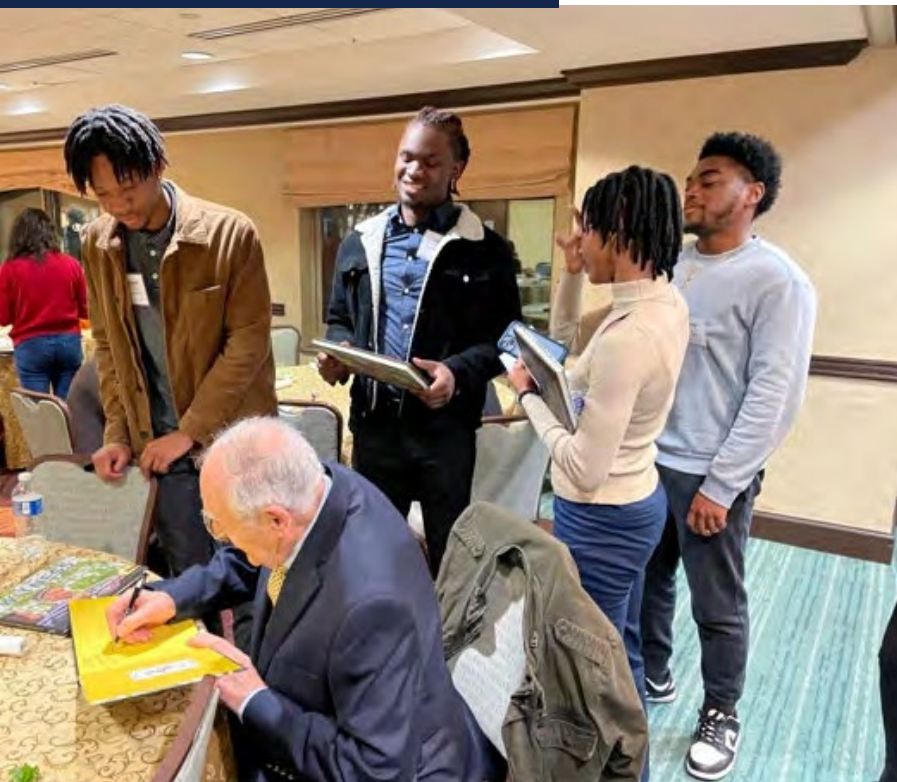
